Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to be hosting the annual Year 11 Record of Achievement (ROA) evening at Flint High School on **Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June at 6pm**. The evening will be a chance for you and your child to recognize and celebrate their time at Flint High School.

In order to ensure we are able to accommodate our guests and the friends and families of our students, we would appreciate you completing the slip at the end of this letter telling us how many guests your son or daughter would like to invite. Parking facilities on the night will be available in the lower carpark at Flint High School adjacent to Northop Road, or the carpark around the corner at Ysgol Maes Hyfryd. **The top carpark outside the main entrance to the school and the bus stop at the front of the school will be closed. Please do not park here, as this is where the buses will collect the students to take them to Prom.**

Following the ROA celebration, your son or daughter (should they have chosen to do so) will travel to our Prom venue to continue an evening of celebration with their friends and members of staff. We will be leaving school by coach at approximately 7pm and return at approximately 12.30am. The coaches are booked to leave the venue at midnight. Please ensure that arrangements have been made for your son or daughter to return home safely once we arrive back at school. If they have booked their own transport, then the driver will follow the coaches to the venue.

I am very excited to be part of these celebrations and am very much looking forward to the evening as are the students themselves. I would like to remind all students that this is an evening of celebration but that, as always, the highest standards of behaviour during the evening will be expected.
